Details of the scholarship:

Purpose and objectives

- To encourage and support ballet students throughout the Wellington Region.
- To acknowledge a student's diligence and commitment to dance.
- To assist students who would otherwise would be unable to attend if it weren't for the scholarship

Eligibility

Candidates must be enrolled or registered for the 2021 year and be 9 years of age and under 17 years of age or equivalent as at the application date. In addition, the candidate must have been studying at a minimum of grade 3 or equivalent during 2020.

Award of the Scholarship

Interviews may be conducted after the closing date if required.

The award of the scholarship will be announced towards the end of the year for the following year and will be at the sole discretion of the En Pointe Dance Academy Principal.

The scholarship will be a 50% reduction in the base tuition fees. Base tuition fees are the syllabus classes required to attend per week for the 2021 year. Additional lessons either private or recommended and extra exam practises will not be covered by the scholarship.
